



Your New Recycling Bin

Starting in June 2010 the Automated Collection Truck will begin collecting your new "Wheelie" Recycling Bins. You will find that using your "Wheelie" recycling bin, is as easy as

Steps to Using the Bin:

1. Collect recyclables in your blue box
DO NOT tie or bag recyclables
2. Empty your blue box in wheelie bin
Keep lid closed at all times
3. Set out when full or nearly full on your collection day.

COLLECT

Collect all your recyclable materials using your blue box in the home!
TIP: For a detailed list of acceptable materials, refer to the label located on the lid of your new "wheelie" bin!



Empty your blue box and fill up your "wheelie" bin!
TIP: Just place all the recyclable items loose in the bin. Do not bag or tie anything to help us separate better with the exception of plastic bags and shredded paper which should be bagged before being placed in the bin. Keep the lid closed at all times. Record your "wheelie" bin serial number for reference. Alternate bin sizes are available upon request.

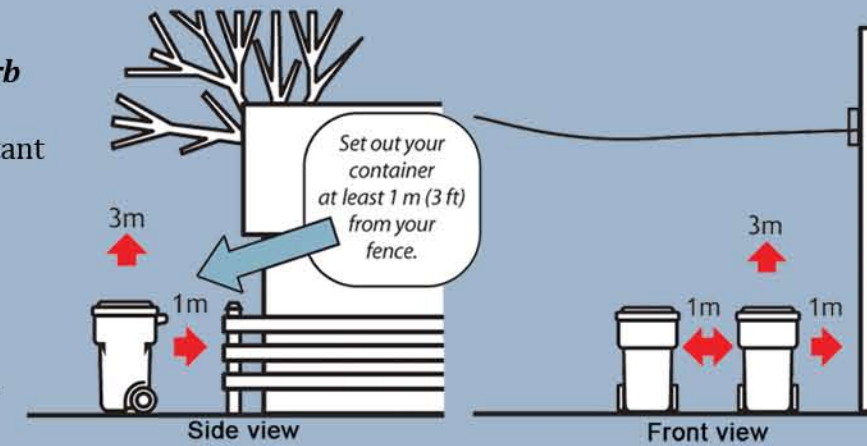

SET OUT

Set out your "wheelie" bin at the curb when full (or almost full).
TIP: Proper placement is very important to ensure trouble free service. Set out your new "wheelie" bin **at least 3 feet (1m)** away from other objects with the wheels and handle pointing towards the house and the lid opening towards the road. If you have excess or oversize materials take them to one of the convenience depots.



Paper

Newspapers, Magazines, Pizza Boxes, Flattened Cardboard, Flyers, Egg Cartons, Paper Towel Rolls, Bagged Shredded Paper

Glass

Clear and Coloured Glass Food and Beverage Containers with lids and/or labels

Plastic

Rigid Bottles with ♻️, ♻️, and ♻️ and Wide Mouth Tub ♻️ - ♻️, and Grocery and retail bags. ♻️ ♻️

Metal

Aluminum and Steel Beverage and Food Cans, Empty Aerosol Containers and Empty Paint Cans, All Metal Lids.
