GARBAGE ONLY

(Applicable to co-collection service only)

Only standard size garbage bags, cans or bundles weighing no more than 45 lbs (20 kg) will be collected.

- disposable diapers
- ceramics, dishes, window glass
- light bulbs, ovenware, crystal

- light bulbs, ovenware, crystal plastic lids, toys and tools
 foom containers and trays
 metal pots
 waxed or coated boxes, milk containers
 meat, fish, grease, bones, dairy products
- other regular household waste

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Large items (such as mattresses, chairs, refrigerators, freezers)
 Hazardous waste

- Radioactive waste
- Construction and demolition waste
- Explosive waste (ammunition)

- Please flatten and bundle 30" x 30" x 8" all cardboard
