Starting Tuesday, January 3rd, residents of Wingham will be serviced by the Bluewater Recycling Association for its curbside blue box collection. By using your blue box regularly and by taking other means to reduce and reuse, you are playing an important part in protecting our environment and preserving our natural resources.

The Bluewater Recycling Association has provided this "Blue Box Brochure" to introduce you to the many items we currently accept in our Blue Box program. We hope you will keep this "Blue Box Brochure" on hand for the next several weeks as you begin recycling with the Association.

## What's New

Please review the list of acceptable materials carefully as it may have changed from your previous service provider. For example, we accept plastic shopping bags, fine paper, empty aerosol containers, empty paint cans, aluminum foil and pie plates. However, we do not accept milk containers, and some plastic containers. Drivers are instructed to leave unacceptable materials in your blue box for you to dispose of appropriately. ## Collection Schedule

Your collection day will be weekly on Tuesday. Please be sure to put your blue box on the proper side (see below) of the road by **7:00 am** to ensure uninterrupted service. Your current side may change. Therefore, place your recyclables on the side of the road where the driver leaves your blue box.

## Holidays

There will be no collection during any holidays. If your collection is scheduled for Christmas Day and New Years Day; then your collection will be rescheduled for the Saturday in between.

## Need a Bluebox?




If your blue box is broken, bring it in and it will be replaced free of charge. We carry a few on the truck for that purpose as well. If yours has gone missing you may get a replacement at the municipal office.


To help you store and put out your recyclables, you may purchase another blue box at a cost of \$6 from the Municipal Office or use a cardboard box if it is just temporary.



## Commercial Cardboard


Cardboard will be collected from businesses generating quantities of one cubic yard or less. If you generate more than that, you may use the cardboard depot at the landfill. Alternatively, cardboard bins are available at a nominal charge to businesses generating large quantities of cardboard. To get your bin simply call Mars Environmental at 1-800-642-BINS (2467).
