Here is a current list of acceptable recycling materials

Paper



Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Boxboard, Cardboard, Flyers, Cartons, Paper Egg Trays Paper Towel Rolls, Bagged Shredded Paper

Glass



Clear and Coloured Glass, Food and Beverage Containers with lids and/or labels No window pane or drinking glasses

Plastic



Metal



Aluminum and Steel Beverage and Food Cans, Empty Aerosol Containers and Empty Paint Cans, All Metal Lids

Not Acceptable Plastic



- No foam containers of any kind
- No containers or materials previously used for hazardous materials
- No pails or buckets exceeding a twenty (20) litre capacity
- No biological containers such as plant trays or pots
- No other plastic items such as toys, tools, lawn furniture, etc
- No construction materials such as pipe, hose, tubing, siding, etc



Steps to using Bin:

1) Collect your recyclables in your blue box.

2) Do not bag except shredded paper or grocery bags

3) Place materials in wheelie bin and set out when nearly full
